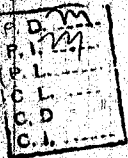


GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.



This Indenture, Made and entered into this 2nd day of May, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Samuel W. Daniels and Marion Daniels, his wife, of Ramona, D.T., part ies of the first part, and of May 11, D.T. part y of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said part ies of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred no/100.### Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part y of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: all of lot four (4) in block seventy-six (76) in the town of Ellensville, Cherokee Territory.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Marion Daniels, wife the said Samuel W. Daniels, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part y of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part y of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
