

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 21st day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between J. C. Scully and Mary A. Scully his wife of Haskell Co. parties of the first part, and Union Land & Investment Co. of Muskogee Co. party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixteen Thousand Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: The north east quarter of the south east quarter of Section Twelve (12) Township sixteen (16) north and Range Three (3) east containing 40 acres more or less

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Mary A. Scully, wife the said J. C. Scully, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
