GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.



This Indenture, Made and entered into this 31 day of May, one thousand nine hundred and zero, by and between J.F. Mueling and Annie Mueling and his wife H.F. Smith of Tulsa, Ok., parties of the first part, and of Eulsa, Ok. part of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred eighty-five Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
all of lot numbered thirteen (13) and four (4) Block numbered twenty (20) situated in Muskogee Creek National Indian Territory according to the recorded plat thereof

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Annie Mueling, wife the said J.F. Mueling, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
