GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

WITNESSETH: That the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: all of the south west quarter of the south west quarter of the north east quarter; the east half of the north west quarter of the south east quarter; the south west quarter of the north east quarter of the south east quarter; the west half of the south east quarter of the south east quarter; all in section thirty five (35) township twenty two (22) north range fourteen (14) east, the above being a part of my old homestead, and having been a part of my old homestead, and having been a part of my old homestead, together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, _____, wife the said _____, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
