

## GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

of Broken Arrow 9.7 part 4 of the second part, WITNESSETH: That the said part 4 of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty six hundred twenty five Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part 4 of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in  Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

The East half of the northwest quarter of section thirty-two and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section twenty-seven in Township eighteen north and Range fourteen east of the Indian Base and meridian in Indian Territory.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Gussie Burgess, wife the said Gussie Burgess,

for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 4 of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part 4 of the second part heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
