

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 1st day of July, one thousand nine hundred and 7, by and between Willie Barnette and

Edgar A. De Munnis of Porter T.T., part 4 of the first part, and of Muskogee T.T., part 4 of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said part 4 of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do sell hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part 4 of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: The East half of the Northeast quarter and the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 13, Township 18 North Range 14 East.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Willie Barnette, wife the said Edgar A. De Munnis,

for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 4 of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part 4 of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
