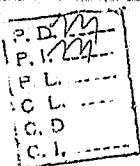


GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.



This Indenture, Made and entered into this 26 day of Sept, one thousand nine hundred and Six, by and between G. L. Elmore and Clara E. Elmore of Broken Arrow, part of the first part, and John M. Smith of Tulsa, I.T. part of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Two Hundred & fifty Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Oklahoma Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

3 1/2 of the N E 1/4 and Lot Two (2) in Section Two (2) Township Eighteen N (18) Range Thirteen (13) E.

The above is made subject to a certain oil and gas Lease made to the E. R. Marshall oil and gas Co. and I hereby assign all of my interest in said oil & gas lease to John M. Smith.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Clara E. Elmore, wife the said G. L. Elmore,

for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
