

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this First day of July, one thousand nine hundred and zero, by and between Daniel Company (a widower) and H. V. Thompson of Bogalusa, Miss. part of the first part, and of Burney Ind. Co. part of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand & no Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: The north half of the south west quarter less one & 1/10 acres occupied as right of way by the St. Louis and San Francisco Railroad and the south east quarter of the north west quarter of section thirty two (32) township nineteen (19) north and Range twelve (12) east of the Indian Base and meridian in the Indian Territory containing one hundred & eighteen & 1/10 acres more or less as the same may be according to the United States survey thereof together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, H. V. Thompson, wife the said Burney Ind. Co., for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
