WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$100)

Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Western District Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

Lot 6, Sec. 6, T. 1 N. R. 10 E. and Nine (9) in Block No. thirty five (35) in the town of Broken Arrow Ind. Ter.  
In trust that said premises shall be used, kept, maintained, and disposed of as a place of divine worship for the use of the ministry and membership of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, subject to the discipline, usage, and ministerial appointments of said church as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Conference of said church, and by the annual conference within whose bounds the said premises are situated.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Annie Wolf wife of Wm Wolf, B. R. Sheets wife of W. J. Sheets, Alice Haymes wife of Frank L. Haymes, Maggie O. Laws wife of L. Lowe, and Annie Tiller wife of B. R. Tiller, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part to heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
