GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 12th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Frank C. Haisky and Henrietta Haisky of Broken Arrow, D.T. part 1 of the first part, and

of Broken Arrow, D.T. part 4 of the second part,
WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Seep Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Henrietta Haisky, wife the said Frank C. Haisky, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
