

# GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 9th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Austin Cowans and Hettie Cowans, his wife of Broken Arrow, part is of the first part, and George C. Castillo and Fred Riskey of Broken Arrow, D.T. part is of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty seven hundred fifty + 7/10 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said parties of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Oreek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: The East half of the Northwest quarter and lot Two (2) of section seven (7) Township Nineteen (19) North and Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian containing 12 acres more or less the same being the allotment of Austin Cowans

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Hettie Cowans, wife the said Austin Cowans, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said parties of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
