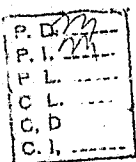


GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

WITNESSETH: That the said part of of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and twenty one and 20/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Okla. Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

Lot number Ninety, Twenty one, and Twenty two in Block number thirty six in the town of Broken Arrow, Okla.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Myrtle E. Rhyme, wife the said J. H. Rhyme, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of of the second part heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
