

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 31st day of October, one thousand nine hundred and six, by and between W. G. Cooper and Eliza Cooper of Broken Arrow, part ys of the first part, and of Broken Arrow part ys of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said part ys of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part ys of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Levek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

Lots 9, 10, 11 & 12 in Block 15 (Fifteen town of Broken Arrow and all improvements thereon belonging to the lots.)

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Eliza Cooper, wife of the said W. G. Cooper, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part ys of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part ys of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
