

passage of time, or by any act, omission or neglect of the Railroad Company, or failure of the Railroad Company to exercise its option to declare said right and permission forfeited when it might avail itself of such option, create any tenure, estate or interest in land whatsoever, nor vest any interest or estate absolute in the Gulf Company and as against the Railroad Company, and the Gulf Company agrees never to claim any such tenure, estate or interest in land, or vested interest.

7. This contract shall inure to the benefit of, and be binding upon the successors and assigns of both parties hereto.
