Now come John N. Day and W. Lyle Dickey, who each being duly sworn on oath say:

That on the 14th, day of January 1907, the said W. Lyle Dickey and his wife May Williams Dickey, executed a mortgage unto him, the said John N. Day, and one Lon R. Stansbery, to secure the payment of a note mentioned therein for the sum of Two Hundred and Seventy (\$270) Dollars, which said mortgage was filed for record in the office of the United States Clerk and Recorder at Tulsa, then Indian Territory, February 2, 1907, at 10.50 A. M. and recorded in Book 3, page 154; said mortgage covering Lot Six (6) in Block Two (2) in Stansberry Addition to the City of Tulsa, Western District, Indian Territory, according to the recorded plat thereof, said Lot Six (6), Block Two (2) being a part of the Stansberry Addition to the City of Tulsa, now State of Oklahoma.

That on the 19th day of August 1908, the said W. Lyle Dickey fully paid said note to this affiant, John N. Day and the said Lon R. Stansbery and said note and said mortgage securing the same are fully discharged and settlement of the same has been made in full.

That on said 19th, day of August 1908, one of the affiants herein, John N. Day and Lon R. Stansbery made a release of said mortgage dated August 19, 1908, which was filed for record in the office of the register of Deeds within and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, August 19, 1908, at 3:45 P. M. and recorded in Book 44, page 266. In said release the amount of said debt was not mentioned and the record book and page of same was omitted.

Now this affidavit is made to fully set at rest any and all doubts as to the payment of said debt and the release of said mortgage. The release last mentioned above was made with the intention and for the purpose of showing full payment of said debt and that said mortgage was fully discharged, and that said Day and Stansbery were the owners of said note when so paid.
