

7th. Second parties shall have free use of the land herein conveyed for the purpose of erecting and maintaining such tankage as may be necessary for the carrying of oil produced by said second parties on the above described property.

8th. For and in consideration of the obligations entered into by the second parties and the payment of the sum of Five Dollars, the option is hereby granted to the second parties to cancel this lease at any time after the expiration of --- years from the date hereof, by giving Thirty (30) days written notice to first party of its intention to do so and remove its property from the premises and surrender possession of the same to first party and cancel this lease of record and payment of all rentals and said first party hereby agree that said payment of Five Dollars is a valuable consideration held and deemed by them sufficient to support each and every one of its options, rights and privileges granted by this lease to second parties and to be so construed.

All moneys due on this lease may be paid to said lessors personally or by check deposited to the credit of Amanda Bertholf, in First National Bank of Checotah, Okla., the date of depositing such check to be treated as the day of payment.

All the above stipulations, obligations and conditions of this grant shall be binding on both part hereto, and they shall apply with equal force to their heirs, assigns and legal representatives.
