FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF TEN & 65/100 Dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged Osage & Oklahoma Company, Tulsa, Okla., do hereby grant to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right of ~~way~~ to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas, and erect, maintain, operate and remove telegraph and telephone lines if the ~~same~~ shall be found necessary on, over and through certain lands situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as follows:

West Half of North West Quarter, Section 3, Township 19 North, Range 13 East. with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantors their heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, and it is hereby further agreed that the above payment is in full of all damages for the constructing, maintaining, operating, relaying and removing the said pipe lines.

And the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration and subject to the same conditions.
