

RIGHT OF WAY.

83A Collinsville Extension 12" Trunk Line.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF TWELVE 00/100 Dollars to her in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged Florence E. Cox, Sapulpa Okla., does hereby grant to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas through certain lands situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of N $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 36 Twp. 21 N. Range 13 E., said line to be laid 18 inches below the surface, with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantor heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, and it is hereby further agreed that the above payment is in full of all damages for the constructing maintaining, operating, relaying and removing the said pipe lines. And that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration and subject to the same conditions.
