#46 Collinsville Extension 12" Trunk Line.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF SIX & 20/100 Dollars to him in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged G. G. Sharpe, does hereby grant to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas, on, and over and through certain lands in Tulsa County, of Oklahoma, described as follows:

North Half, of South West Quarter of Section 4, Township 19 North, range 13 East, with ingress and egress, to and from the same.

The said grantor, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except as hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, and it is hereby further agreed that the above payment is in full of all damages for the construction, maintaining, operating relaying and removing the said pipe lines.

And the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions.
