RIGHT OF WAY

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF ONE DOLLARS to ---- in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged Winnie MacIntosh do hereby grant to the Galbreath Gas Co., a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right-of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas, and erect, maintain, operate and remove telegraph or telephone lines if the same shall be found necessary, on, over and through certain lands situate in --- County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows:

W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 27, Twp. 19 Range N, 12 East, with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantor heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Galbreath Gas Co., and it is hereby further agreed that the above payment is in full of all damages for the constructing, maintaining, operating, relaying and removing the said pipe lines.

And the said Galbreath Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration and subject to the same conditions.
