FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF FOURTEEN & 95/100 (\$14.95)

Dollars to him in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged Hilroy O. Ellis, minor, by John W. Ellis, Guardian do hereby grant to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right of way to lay maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines, for the transportation of gas, and erect, maintain and operate telegraph and telephone lines if the same shall be found necessary on, over and through certain lands situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows:

East Half of North West Quarter of North West Quarter Section 13, Township 20 North,
Range 13 East with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantor, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, which hereby agrees to pay all damages that may arise to crops and fences from the laying, maintaining and operating said pipe lines; said damages if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, on thereof to be appointed by the said grantor, heirs or assigns, one by the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.

And it is hereby further agreed that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions.
