#51 A. Collinsville Extension 12" Trunk Line.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF SEVEN & 50/100 Dollars/ to her in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged H. L. Sheppard, Tulsa, Okla., does hereby grant to Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas, and erect, maintain and operate telegraph or telephone lines if the same ^{shall} be found necessary on, over and through certain lands situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as follows,

SE. 1/4 of SE. 1/4 ^{SW 1/4} Sec 34, Twp. 20 Range 13 with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantor, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore grants to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, which hereby agrees to pay all damages which may arise to crops and fences from laying, maintaining, and operating said pipe lines; said damages if not mutually agreed upon to be determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the grantor or heirs or assigns, one by the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.

And it is hereby further agreed that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration and subject to the same conditions.
