RIGHT OF WAY.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF FIFTY DOLLARS? to him in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged John C. Lunsford, Beggs, Okla., do hereby grant to Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas, and erect, maintain and operate telegraph and telephone lines if the same shall be found necessary on, over and through certain lands situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows:

The SW4 of the SE4 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, Township 19 N., Range 12 E. And Lot 6 Section 25, Township 19 N., Range 12 E. with ingress and egress to and from the same. +

The said Grantors heirs or ---- to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma, Natural Gas Company, which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise to crops and fences from the laying, maintaining, operating, ~~relaying and removing~~ of said pipelines, said damages if not mutually agreed upon to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said grantor, his heirs or assigns, one by the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors and assigns, and the third by the two so appointed; ~~as aforesaid~~, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.

And it is hereby further agreed that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided upon the payment of a like consideration and subject to the same conditions.
