The Court further finds that Kate Thomas died intestate in what is now Hughes County, Oklahoma, on or about the ---- day of September 1899, leaving as her sole and only heirs at law Lillie Miller, a sister; Minnie Goat, nee Thomas, a sister; Milly Goat, nee Thomas a sister; Emma Thomas, a sister and Bettie Thomas a sister; that Kate Thomas never had any children born to her and that she had no other heirs but the ones above mentioned.
