RENTAL CONTRACT.

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 4th, day of September 1909, by and between Wilson Roland, of Tulsa County, for----- and on behalf of----- and R. H. Kirk, parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the party of the second part, the party of the first part this day and by these presents do demise and let to the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns for farming purposes, for the term of five years from the 1st, day of January 1910 the following described parcels of land:

South East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 13, Township 16 N., Range 12 E.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the second part will pay to the party of the first part a rental of One Hundred and no/100 Dollars per annum during the term of the contract, payable as follows:

\$100.00 cash in hand the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, for 1910. \$10.00 on the 4th, day of September 1909, on year 1911. \$40.00 July 1st 1911: \$50.00 every six months during the term of this contract.
