WITNESSETH: That said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other valuable considerations in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents release, convey sell and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever the following described real estate situated in the Indian Territory, Western Judicial District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

One Half of all my interest in and to the South East Quarter of Section Eighteen (18) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, in the Indian Territory.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging, to the only proper use, benefit and behalf of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
