## RIGHT-OF-WAY.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF FOUR & 95/100 Dollars to her in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged Sarah Tombson, Towser, Claremore, Okla., does hereby grant to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas, and erect, maintain, operate and remove telegraph or telephone lines if the same shall be found necessary on, over and through certain lands situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows:

North West Quarter of NE4 of Sec. 19, Twp. 21 N. Range 14 E. with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said Grantor, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, and it is hereby further agreed that the above payment is in full of all damages for the constructing, maintaining, operating, relaying and removing the said pipe lines.

And that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration and subject to the same conditions.
