FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF NINE & 40/100 Dollars to him in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged James Arwood, Guardian of Roy Arwood, do hereby grant to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right-of-way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas, and erect, maintain, operate and remove telegraph or telephone lines if the same shall be found necessary on, through and over certain lands situate in ---- County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows:

The NE4 of SW4 of the SW4 of Sec. 17 Twp. 21, Range 14 East, with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantor, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, and it is hereby further agreed that the above payment is in full of all damages for the constructing, maintaining, operating, relaying and removing the said pipe lines.

And that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns may at any time lay an additional line of pipe along side of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration and subject to the same conditions.
