

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF TWO & 50/100 Dollars to him in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged Sallie Marshall, nee Rookey, do hereby grant to the Galbreath Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas, and erect, maintain, operate and remove telegraph or telephone line if the same shall be necessary on, over and through certain land situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit: SW4 of the NW4 of Sec. 23, Twp 19, Range 12 East, with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantors, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes thereinbefore granted to the said Galbreath Gas Company, and it is hereby further agreed that the above payment is in full of all damages for the constructing, maintaining, operating, relaying and removing the said pipe lines.

And that the said Galbreath Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration and subject to the same conditions.
