RIGHT-OF-WAY.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF FIFTEEN & 10/100 DOLLARS to him in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged L. H. Rogers, Guardian of Essie D. & Nettie E. Rogers, minors, Collinsville, Okla., does hereby grant to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas, and erect, maintain and operate telegraph or telephone lines if the same shall be found necessary, on, over and through certain lands situate in Tulsa County, of Oklahoma, described as follows:

SE4 of SW4 & NW4 of SE4 of Section 17, Township 21 N. Range 14 East, with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantor, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, which hereby agrees to pay all damages which may arise to crops and fences from the laying, maintaining and operating said pipe lines; said damages if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said grantor, heirs or assigns, one by the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.
