RIGHT-OF-WAY.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF ELEVEN AND NO/100 Dollars, to him in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged W. M. Blankenship, Dawson, Okla., does hereby grant to Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas through certain lands situate in Tulsa County, of Oklahoma, described as follows:

E2 of S2 of N₄ & Ne4 of SW4 of S2 of NE4 Sec. 23, Twp. 20, Range 13 East, with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantor heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise to crops or fences from the laying, maintaining and operating said pipe lines; said damages if not mutually agreed upon, to be determined and ascertained by three disinterested persons, one thereof, to be appointed by the said grantor heirs or assigns, one by the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.

And it is hereby further agreed that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company/ may at any time lay an additional line of pipe along side of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration and subject to the same conditions.
