ASSIGNMENT

Tulsa, Oklahoma, April 12, 1907.

Know all men by the presents;

That I, Charles H. Bosler, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, and other good and valuable considerations, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby transfer and assign unto The Tulsa Street Railway Company, a corporation under the laws of the Indian Territory, all my right, title and interest, in and to a certain franchise grant from the City of Tulsa, I. T. , to-wit: An Ordinance granting to Charles H. Bosler, his associates, heirs, representatives and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain and electric or street railway on the Streets, avenues and public ways of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, and regulating the construction, operation and maintenance thereof" passed by the City Council and Mayor of the City of Tulsa, April 5th, 1907, and accepted by me as therein provided on the 8th, day of April 1907. This transfer shall be binding upon me, my associates, heirs and representatives.
