

W. H. Booth on the South Half of the South East Quarter, Section Twenty One, Township Eighteen North, Range Fourteen East (S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21, Tn. 18 N. R. 14 E.) Tulsa County, Oklahoma, consisting of Eighty (80) Acres more or less.

Party of the first part for the above named consideration also transfers, assigns, conveys and sets over to the party of the second part, all the right, title, claim and interest which he may have in and to the drilling tools and property involved in the said suit in the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in which J. M. Bradley, I. N. Johnson, W. T. Dalton, J. C. Dalton and G. L. Dalton are plaintiffs and L. C. Conroy, party of the first part herein is defendant, in which plaintiffs are suing defendant for certain drilling tools, material and other property, as itemized in statement of which is set out in the petition in said suit.

And I hereby authorize the said party of the second part to settle or compromise said suit or to carry same thru to final determination in my name for his benefit.

Party of the first part for said consideration also assigns and sets over and transfers to party of the second part, all his right, title, claim and interest in and to the drilling material and casing involved in a suit now pending in the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in which S. J. Smallwood is plaintiff and L. C. Conroy is defendant, and which said Smallwood is seeking replevin on a quantity of casing from the said L. C. Conroy; and I hereby authorize party of the second part to compromise or settle said suit or to fight the same thru to final judgement as he may see fit and to do so in my name for his benefit.

Party of the first part also agrees to dismiss with prejudice his suit in District Court of Tulsa, Oklahoma, against J. M. Bradley, I. N. Johnson, W. T. Dalton, J. U. Dalton and G. L. Dalton, and releases said parties from all liability.
