

A G R E E M E N T.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, D. D. White for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations to me in hand paid by J. N. Bradley, W. T. Dalton J. C. Dalton and C. L. Dalton, hereinafter known as the parties of the second part, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby sell, convey and transfer to the parties of the second part, all of my right, title, claim and interest in and to the oil and gas leases mentioned and described in a partnership contract entered into on the 9th, day of May 1909 by and between J. Conroy, Also sell, convey, transfer and assign all the right, title claim and interest I may have in certain drilling tools and materials involved in a suit pending in the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in which J. M. Bradley, I. M. Johnson, W. T. Dalton, J. C. Dalton and C. L. Dalton are plaintiff and L. C. Conroy is defendant, in which suit the plaintiffs are seeking to replevin said drilling tools and materials and other property, an itemized statement of which is set out in the petition of said suit.
