

WARRANTY DEED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT THE ALSUMA TOWNSITE COMPANY, a corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the Act of Congress of February 18, 1901 (providing for the formation of corporations in the Indian Territory) in consideration of One Dollar Dollars cash in hand, paid to it by F. A. Homeyer, Burton, Texas, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto F. A. Homeyer, all the following described parcel of land situate in the town of Alsuma, Tulsa County, Oklahoma (according to the survey and plat of town embraced in the land described as the East Half of the Southwest Quarter and Lot Three (3) of Section Thirty (30), Township Nineteen (19), Range Fourteen (14) East, according to the United States Survey), said parcel of land being known and designated upon the plat thereof as:

Lot Numbered Eleven (11) Block Numbered Forty Four (44): Together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging and warrant the title to the same.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE AFOREGRANTED PREMISES unto the said F. A. Homeyer, and his heirs, successors and assigns forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgements/ mortgages and other liens and incumbrances of whatsoever nature.
