Sampson, Guardian of Joe Sampson, a minor, relative to an application of said Guardian for permission to execute and deliver to the Prairie Oil & Gas Company a Grant in the nature of an easement for the construction and operation of a pipe line and a telegraph and telephone line over and across the lands of said minor in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, Township 17, Range 13. And it appearing to the Court from said report that the right of way for said pipe line and telegraph and telephone line, executed by said guardian and made a part of said report, are in all respects made in conformity to the orders heretofore made in said proceedings and that said Guardian has received Forty Eight & 50/100 Dollars in full consideration thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ordered and adjudged by the Court that the report of said Guardian be and the same is hereby in all respects ratified, confirmed and approved, and that the said Guardian is authorized and directed to deliver to The Prairie Oil & Gas Company said grant of right of way.

ORDER APPROVING RIGHT OF WAY GRANT.
