DEED OF GUARDIAN.

White and unto his herrs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest and estate of said minor, Doctor Grayson, or which the said minor was possessed at the time said sale was made, in and to all of a certain lot, piece or parcel of lamb, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The North West Quarter of Section 16, Township 19 North, Range 14 East, situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and containing 160 acres, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the above described premises, together with the appurtenances thereunto belonging into the said C. C. C. White, his heirs and assigns forever.
