QUIT CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 23rd, day of September in the year A. D. 1909, between Minerva C. Miller, single of Vigo Co. Indiana, of the first part and C. W. Deming, of Tulsa Co., Oklahoma, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) Dollars, to her duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby quitclaim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all her right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate situate in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The East half of Lot No. 2, Block No. 9, Highlands Addition to Tulsa, Okl., as per plat of the same on file in the office of the Register of Deeds, Tulsa Co., Okl.
Having inadvertently deeded the above described property to the party of the first part instead of another lot
This Quitclaim is given to rectify an error made by John H. Miller, of Tulsa Co., Okl. said deed being dated August, 12th, 1908, and filed Aug. 12th, 1908 in the office of the
