

ORIGINAL CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT.

THIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 26th, day of June 1909, by and between the Margaret Oil Company, a corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and the Central Light and Fuel Company, a corporation of Sapulpa, Oklahoma, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: THAT, WHEREAS: <sup>(+12)</sup> The party of the first part is the owner of certain Gas pipe lines, and the fittings, connections and appliances incident and necessary to the use thereof, and is also the owner of certain rights of way necessary and incident to the use of said pipe lines situated in the Counties of Tulsa <sup>and</sup> Creek, which said lines are more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

APPROXIMATELY: 50800' 4" line, from center of North line of Sec. 29-19-12 (Postoak) to S.E. Corner of Sec. 33-18-12 (Gulf Station No. 3).

6810' 3" line, from center of East line to center of West line Sec. 6-18-12 (C. L. & F. Co. line to McGuire No. 2, via Gray No. 1)

805' 2 1/2" line, from McGuire No. 3 to R. R. in Sec. 1-18-11.

2140' 2" line from R. R. to Martha Bigpond No. 2.

1325' 2" line, Tanaha City Line.

2245' 2" line, from Martha Bigpond No. 2, to No. 1.

1575' 2" line, from Martha Bigpond No. 1 to connection with 4" line in Sec. 6-18-12.

19780' 3" line, from S.E. Corner Sec. 33-18-12 to Texas Pump Station near Kiefer.

3620' 3" line, from Main Line Central Light and Fuel Company to The Sapulpa Refining Co. plant.
