to lay, maintain and operate a pipe line, diagonally across the land, and a telegraph or telephone line, in the public road or 3 ft or less from the fence line no wenclosing said land, to the transportation of crude petroleum over and across the saidpremises, with ingress and egress to and from the same; the said party of the first part to fully use and enjoy said premises for the purposes herein granted, the party of the second part to pay all damages which may arise to crops or fences and any other damages, caused by the laying, maintaining and operating of said pipe line and telegraph or telephone line said damages if not mutually agreed upon to be ascertained and determined by three (3) disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said Grantor, one by The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.

And it is hereby further agreed, the the said The Prairie Oll & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional pipe line alongsider of the first line, as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions; also to have the right to change the size of its pipes, the damage, if any, in making such change to be dtermined and paid by the said The Prairie Oil and Gas Company as in the manner as above provided.

The pipe line to be buried 18 inches or more below the surface.
