OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT,
CHEROKEE NATION, INDIAN TERRITORY.

(Sec., 72, Act of July 1, 1902, 32 Stat., 716, 726.)

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into in quadruplicate, on this 1st, day of March A. D. 1905, by and between James P. Lloyd, guardian of the person and estate of Pansy B. Lloyd, minor, of Tulsa, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and A. B. Smith Drilling Company, of Muskogee, Indian Territory, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of South Dakota, and duly organized to carry on business in the Indian Territory, by compliance with the Act of Congress, approved February 18, 1901 (31 Stat., 794) party of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 72 of the Act of Congress, approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.

WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the party of the second part; its successors and assigns, do hereby (demise, grant and let) unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, for the period of years ending February 27th, 1918, from the date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land lying and being within the Cherokee Nation and within the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The NE4 of the NE4 of the NE4 of Section 19, Township 20 N., Range 13 E.; and the NE4 of the NW4 of Section 20, Township 20 N., Range 13 E., and the South half of the NE4 of the SE4 and the NE4 of the NE4 of the SE4 of Section 26, Township 20 N., Range 12E of the Indian Meridian and containing 80 acres, more or less, with the right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store, refine and remove such oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much only of the surface of said land as may be reasonably necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, storing, refining and removing such oil and natural gas, including also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said lands by means of pipe lines or otherwise a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and including still further the right to use such oil and natural gas as fuel so far as it is necessary to the prosecution of said operations.

In consideration of which the said party of the second part hereby agrees and binds itself, its successors and assigns, to pay or cause to be paid to the lessor, as royalty, the sum of twelve and one half per cent. of the value, on the leased premises, of all crude oil extracted from the said land, and if the parties do not, before the tenth day of the
