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PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

IN CONSIDERATION OF FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as partial payment upon a loan of Three Thousand Dollars, I the undersigned owner and holder of a certain real estate mortgage made to Grant R. McCullough by William J.
