

## COMPARED

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 17th, day of September 1909, between John Eaton, of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, party of the first part, and Quintuple Oil Company, a corporation of the State of West Virginia, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part for a valuable consideration to him in handpaid by the said party of the second part, the receipt and payment whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold transferred and set over and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all those certain leasehold estates, situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and described as follows to-wit:
