RIGHT-OF-WAY.

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of Sixteen and 50/100 (\$16.50) Dollars this day paid to The Prairie Oil & Gas Company by The Gulf Pipe Line Company, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company does hereby grant and convey unto the said The Gulf Pipe Line Company, its successors and assigns, the right to locate, maintain and operate a four inch water line for the purpose of conveying water over, through and upon a certain tract of land situated in Tulsa County and State of Oklahoma and described as follows:

Beginning at a point near and South of the Northwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 18 North, Range 12 East, thence running in an easterly direction close to and parallel with the north line of said tract of land to the East Boundary thereof, being a distance of about 165 rods 2 1/2 feet.

It is expressly understood that the said line when laid shall not in any way encroach upon or interfere with the tanks and firebanks surrounding tanks on said tract of land, and that the grantee shall be liable to the grantor, its successors and assigns for any and all damages arising by reason of the laying of said pipe line and the operation thereof. Said line shall be laid as nearly as the same can be done along the line indicated by red ink on the plat of said tract hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit A".

Also, and for the further consideration of the sum of Six and 5/100 (\$6.05) Dollars paid by the said grantee to the said grantor, said grantor does hereby grant and convey unto the said grantee, its successors and assigns, the right to locate, maintain and operate a four inch pipe line for conveying gas, and also a three inch line for conveying water over, through and upon that certain tract of land owned by the grantor and situated in Tulsa County and described as follows:
