CONTRACT FOR PARTITION WALL.

THIS AGREEMENT, Made this 14th, day of August 1909, between G. D. Pierce of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and G. H. Dietrich, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part.
