

The party of the second part shall have the right to use oil , gas and water produced on saidland for operation thereon, except water from wells of first party

When requested by first party the second party shall bury its pipe lines below plough depth.

No well shall be drilled nearer than two hundred feet to the house or barn on said premises.

Second party shall pay for damage caused by drilling, to growing crops on said land.

The party of the second part shall have the right at any time to remove all property of every Kind and nature placed on or in said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing.

The party of the second part, its successors and assigns, shall have the right at any time on thepayment of One Dollar to the party of the first part, his heirs or assigns, to surrender this lease for cancellation, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine, and this lease become absolutely null and void.

All covenants and agreements herein set forth, between the parties hereto shall extend to their successors, executors, administrators and assigns.
