## WARRANTY DEED

TO PROPERTY IN TULSA CEMETERY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That, I, W. D. Abbott, Recorder of the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, for and on behalf of said City for and in consideration of the sum of six and no/100 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said H. I. Kelly and unto his heirs, and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City Cemetery of the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, in the S. One-half of the S. E. Quarter of the S. E. quarter, of Section 1, Township 19, North, Range 12 East, to-wit.

The East half ( $E\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Block Three Hundred, Sixty-nine (369) TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said grantee, H. I. Kelly and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said grantee H. I. Kelly, that the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all claims whatever.
