barred and enjoined from claiming or setting up any right, title, claim, interest, demand, equity, or estate in and to said land or any portion of it, adverse to the interest of this Plaintiff

It is further ordered, adjugged, and decreed that the Plaintiff pay the costs of this action.

It is further ordered that bhe Guardian Ad Litem, F. O. Cavitt be allowed a fee of \$15.00 to be charged as costs.
