OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT/
CREEK NATION? OKLAHOMA.

THIS INSTRUMENT OF LEASE, Made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 27th day of October, A. D. 1909, by and between Thomas Brown Roll # 1815 of Stone Bluff, Okla, a full blood citizen of the Creek nation, party of the first part, hereinafter designated as lessor, and Edw Mac Jaggatt of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee, and in pursuance of the provisions of the act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (Public No. 140), Witnesseth:

1. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations, and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does hereby demise, grant, lease and let unto the lessee, for the term of five years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities, all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land lying and being within the County of Tulsa, and state of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The South half (S1/2) of the North west Quarter (NWQ) of section 17, township 16, range 13, of the Indian Meridian and containing 80 acres, more
