COMPARED

THIS LEASE, made and entered into this Oct, 30, 1909 by and between George Island of Sapulpa, Oklahoma, hereinafter called the lessor, and Wm. A. Bridges of Sapulpa, Oklahoma, hereinafter called the lessee, WITNESSETH:

1. That the lessor owns the following described real estate and premises, situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

SW/4 of SE/4 of section 12-19-10 East, the same being lessor's homestead 40 acres.

2. That the lessor in consideration of the covenants, promises and agreements herein contained and expressed, hereby rents, leases and lets to the lessee, the above described premises, to have and to hold the same from the 1st day of January 1910 to the 31st day of December 1910, together with the buildings and improvements thereon, for agricultural purposes

3. That the lessor covenants to place the lessee in the quiet and peaceable possession of said premises on or before the beginning of the
